ODSI: Interpreting ODSI Search Results

This guide is intended to provide a step-by-step desktop procedure for interpreting ODSI search results within Captis Intelligence’s integrated product suite. For any questions, please contact help@captisintelligence.com to reach one of our product specialists for assistance.

1. Upon completion of an ODSI Search (LINK TO CONDUCTING AN ODSI SEARCH DOCUMENT), scan results will populate and present the following screen:

4. To further investigate each of the match results, click “More Details” to generate a pop-up window with further information.
5. To export and/or print subject dossier, click the drop-down button at the top right-hand side of the pop-up window.

6. Click “Additional Information” to reach the full detail “Person of Interest (POI)” page that contains all Captis Database detail on the subject in question
 - a. In the “Details” Section, you will find the Location and POI Type
 - b. In the “Vitals” Section, you may find the demographic details Captis makes available for investigation purposes
 - c. In the “Charges” Section, you will find the crime details Captis has obtained related to the selected POI
7. Utilizing these details, evaluate against the crime in question and your/your organizations subjective assessment criteria.
